Indianapolis Coin Club
January 9, 2012 Board Meeting

Following a leisurely evening meal, the Board meeting was called to order by President Donn Wray at 6:27 PM, Monday, January 9, at the Northside K of C Hall.

The following 11 Board Members were present: President, Donn Wray; Vice President, Mike White; Treasurer, Don King; Secretary, Vinton Dove; Sergeant-at-Arms, Jim Warden; Past President, Jim Roehrdanz; and Board members Mark Eberhardt, Bob Bettcher, Dave Reid, Ron Jackson and Jim Fuson. Absent were Editor, Matt Dinger and Board Member, Paul Vaughn. A quorum was declared.

Dave Reid declared that he would like for the Board members to send articles to the Editor for inclusion in the Planchet. He asked about including articles from the ANA publication, "The Numismatist," the Central States publication, "The Centinel" and other sources. A discussion followed, and the members were urged to write and send material to Matt.

Copies of the 2008 Budget and a draft of the 2012 Budget were circulated by Donn, and after a lengthy discussion and modification, the Secretary moved and the Past President seconded to approve the Budget. The motion passed. The Total Revenues were \$1,886; Total Expenses, \$1,884; and the Net Surplus, \$2.

The president pointed out that the 4th Monday in May was Memorial Day. The Board decided to meet on the 3rd Monday, May 21, and Mark said he would reserve the date with the K of C.

Dave Reid asked for a committee to be appointed to develop a 75th Anniversary medal for the Club, and circulated several examples of Commemorative Medals. Donn appointed Dave Reid, Chairman, Mark Eberhardt and Vinton Dove, members.

Mike White and Mark Eberhardt have agreed to serve as a committee to undertake youth projects, which will be supported by the Club at the "Second Sunday" show. It is contemplated that the Club will fund acquisition of coins and books for YNs. It was also determined that the Club will provide each youth member with a current or recent Redbook as an additional youth membership benefit in exchange for the \$5 dues.

Moved by Dave Reid and seconded by Bob Bettcher to adjourn. The meeting was adjourned at 7:35 PM.


